## **QUICK ELDERFLOWER CHAMPAGNE (makes 4 ltrs)**

600 g caster sugar; 2 TB white wine vinegar; 30 lg heads of elderflower; grated zest and juice of 3 lemons; 1 tsp dried yeast.

Boil 4 ltrs of water, add sugar and stir over low heat till dissolved, then cool.

Add vinegar, elderflowers, lemon zest and juice.

Sprinkle over dried yeast, cover and leave 24 hrs.

Strain and pour into **wire topped** bottles. Will be ready in 10 days.

Drink within 2-3 weeks.
