SARAH RAVEN SEASONAL RECIPE - BLACKBERRY AND APPLE GIN

10.5 oz gran sugar; 1 apple, peeled, cored and finely chopped; 9 oz blackberries; 750 ml gin.

Pour sugar into a large, sterilised bottle. Add the fruit and then the gin. Seal and store in a dark place. Turn bottle often to dissolve sugar gradually. After 3 months strain off alcohol and pour into dry, warm, sterilised bottles. Seal and label. Keeps well.
